It helps if we notice that the Caterpillar has a big head and a smaller body. Whatever sound we use to make the rhythm, we should be able to hear the head sounding louder.



This is actually also true for other chunks too; the first sound is the most important, and helps us stay together in a group.

...contented has no head note – it starts small and gets louder to show direction towards the next pattern.
